



NATIONAL YOUTH CHESS CHAMPIONSHIPS 2019

(Incorporating National Age-Group and National Junior Chess Championships)

INVITATION

The Malaysian Chess Federation (MCF) invites all MCF States Affiliates to participate in the **National Youth Chess Championship 2019** (MNYCC 2019) to be organized by the **Malaysian Chess Federation** to be held at **Hotel Casuarina @ Meru, Ipoh Perak, Malaysia** from **23th to 27th March 2019**.

ELIGIBILITY OF PARTICIPANTS

1. All **Malaysian** player age below 20 can enter the National Youth Chess Championship 2019. The State Official / State Technical Official (JPN) encourage to send the entries
2. Players under the FIDE flag may also apply to play as **Direct Entries** but must explain their status and entry will be subject to MCF approval
3. To qualify to play in an age-group, players must not reach the designated age before 1st January 2019. They can however choose to play in an older age-group category. All participants are required to bring along their MyKad or Birth Certificate for verification as needed.

TOURNAMENT

1. The MNYCC 2019 will be a FIDE rated tournament and be held over **8** rounds for both Open and Girls in the age-group categories U-8, U-10, U-12, U-14, U-16 and U-18 (National Age-Group Championships) and U-20 (National Junior Championships).
2. Accordingly, the FIDE Laws of Chess together with FIDE Tournament Rules and Regulations will apply.
3. The time control will be 90 minutes with 30 second time increment each to the finish.

The tie-break to determine champions will be a two game 5 minutes Blitz play off and if unresolved will be determined by Armageddon. For all others, it will be: **1) P.E. 2) Buchholz 3) S.B, and 4) Cumulative**

All Players are required proper attire for tournament to follow the code of casual dressing. For men dress trousers or jeans, a long-sleeve or shirt-sleeve, T-shirt, shoes For women dress (No short skirt above the knee)(No beach-wear slippers, etc.)
