## 2016 Wah Seong Penang Chess League Team Tournament

### Tournament Regulations

- This is a team tournament, open to all players.
- The tournament format is a 8-round Swiss System played under the Laws of Chess of the World Chess Federation (FIDE) and the following supplementary rules.
- For the pairings, a Swiss Manager program will be used and paired according to Match Points (2,1,0)
- The tournament is open to teams from these four broad categories: Public Sector (government and quasi-government departments), Factories, Institutions of Learning (schools, colleges & universities) and Others (companies, firms, registered societies/ clubs). Each team shall represent an organization in any of the above categories and only their bona fide employees, members or students can be registered in the team.
- Each team shall comprise of four players. The players should be registered online as per board order upon submission.
- The average players rating (FIDE Standard Rating) per team should not exceed 2250.
- Individual Rating Calculation Method:
  - \*1\* FIDE rated player should register with FIDE rating similar to Penang Open (Dec 2016 FIDE Standard rating).
  - \*2\* FIDE unrated player with MCF Rating must register the rating as MCF rating plus 200 points.
  - \*3\* Foreign unrated players (No FIDE rating and No MCF rating) will be considered as 2000 points for calculation purposes.
  - \*4\* Malaysian unrated players (No FIDE rating and No MCF rating) will be given 1500 points for calculation purposes.
- Each player is accorded a time control of 15 minutes + 10 seconds per move.
- Recording of move is not compulsory.
- There will be no sharing of prizes. The following tie-breaks will be used: (a) MATCH points (b) Game points (c) Solkoff.
- FIDE regulations apply for mobile phones –a player is forbidden to have a mobile phone and/or other electronic means of communication in the playing venue. Penalty is the automatic loss of the game.
